As of January, about **569,462** Overseas Filipino Workers (OFWs) have already been repatriated to the country, with projections that some 100,000 more will be returning in the coming months.

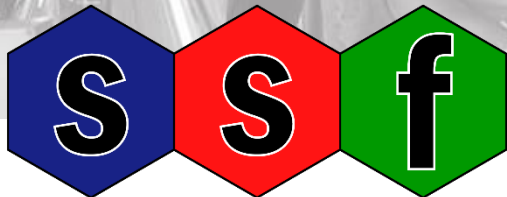

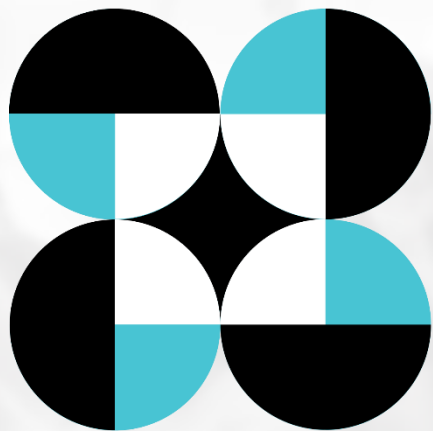
